Computer Curricula Expands

Computer Repair

In an effort to meet a growing demand and also to offer relevant content that expands as technology advances, the ACC has added a second year to the Computer Repair Curriculum. Students may now take a second year of Repair and advance their knowledge into individualized areas of interest, such as networking, security, and virus/malware removal.

Computer Programming

As is with its counterpart Computer Repair, the ACC Intro to Programming class has added a second year course. Whereas the Intro course introduces students to the C# and SQL languages, the second year adds to the programming knowledge by emphasizing OOP (Object Oriented Programming) and 3d App development.

Particulars

Whether a student takes Computer Repair, Programming, or both classes, the ACC emphasizes the application of knowledge in a simulated work environment, as well as the earning of an industry credential. Students may earn Comptia A+ certification, Testout Repair Certification, MTA, or even MOS certifications, all at no cost to the student.
