Starved Rock Associates for Vocational and Technical Education

SRAVTE serves as the Education for Employment (EFE) region overseer for the 10 high schools that comprise the starved rock region. Those 10 high schools are De Pue, Hall, La Moille, La Salle Peru, Mendota, Ottawa, Princeton, Putnam County, Seneca, and Streator. In overseeing the region, SRAVTE is charged with managing the grant funds that are made available through the Federal Carl Perkins V grant and the reciprocal state CTEI grant. In combination these two grants help regional schools support Career and Technical Education (CTE) in a variety of ways. In Fiscal Year 2022 the region received the following amounts from each of these grants.

Perkins: \$210,280

CTEI: \$711,845

The SRAVTE region allocates these funds in accordance with allowable expenditures (as defined by the grant guidelines) and in conjunction with the wishes of the member schools. Below is a breakdown of how the schools allocated their funding.

Regional Highlights:

SRAVTE Summer Showcase:

SRAVTE hosted a Summer showcase in conjunction with the La Salle Peru Area Career Center. 57 Middle school students from across the region (17 different middle schools) participated. Over 30% were non-traditional (Females participating in traditionally male career courses).

Teacher Success Rates:

Across the SRAVTE Region for schools that allocated their money in both teacher salary and teacher aide salary, the success rate (as defined by non-failure) was:

CTEI (Teacher Salary)—90% Success Rate

Perkins (Teacher Aide Salary)—83% Success Rate

Industry Certifications:

Across the region SRAVTE funded initiatives to have students earn industry certifications. In doing so, students earned certifications in the following: OSHA 10 Hour Safety, Serv Safe Food Handlers and Food Managers, ECE (Child Care), A+, Unity, Snap-On Multimeter, MOS-Microsoft Office Specialist, Quickbooks, and AutoDesk.

Single Parent Assistance

The SRAVTE Office employs a single parent coordinator who works with school aged single parents across the region. The coordinator worked with 72 clients this year. She assisted them in finishing their high school diplomas, gaining information on employment, finding resources and care for their children, and gaining information on starting and continuing a college education.
